**1. Call to order**

Administrative Officer Jason Coleman called the GMA #2 meeting to order at 10:02 am.

**2. Roll call and establish a quorum**

Mr. Coleman conducted a roll call of the districts participating in today's meeting. Garza UWCD was absent, but the other six GCDs were present and represented as follows:

**3. Public Comment (Comments will be limited to three (3) minutes regarding agenda items only.)**

No public comment was offered.

**4. Agenda Items**

4.1 Legislative and policy updates

Sen. Charles Perry presented an overview of the past legislative sessions, both regular and special. The members asked several questions regarding the passage of SB7 and

HJR7, along with Proposition 4 on the recent election ballot. The members thanked Sen. Perry for attending the meeting and his leadership on water issues.

4.2 Consider for approval minutes of prior meeting.

Brad Heffington moved to approve the minutes from the March 28, 2025 GMA #2 meeting. Jacob Hernandez seconded the motion. All present voted aye. The motion passed.

4.3 Texas Water Development Board Updates

Robert Bradley shared a presentation of new legislation and how it affects GCD management plans, the submission of desired future conditions, and the TWDB checklist for same items.

4.4 Presentation by Dr. Bill Hutchison regarding Scenario 23 and consider action for next steps.

Dr. Hutchison reviewed the most recent model run (Scenario 23), which was performed using the updated HPAS GAM and employed 2020 as the baseline year. The members asked several questions regarding the differences between this simulation and the existing DFC, as well as other scenarios. Dr. Hutchison recommended that the members take the Scenario 23 results back to their respective districts and analyze the modeled drawdowns. If these results are unsatisfactory, then he may run another scenario for evaluation. The next GMA #2 meeting should be held in February, which will leave adequate time for further review.

4.5 Review water level data for GMA #2 and the status of achieving the DFCs.

The members reviewed a chart of observed water level changes versus the modeled DFC. This data helps the group determine progress toward meeting the current DFC and demonstrates that GMA #2 is meeting its goals.

4.6 Discuss and review the management plans of each district in the management area.

In accordance with Texas Water Code 36.108(c) and (c-1), the members discussed all GCD management plans and current challenges within each district.

Brad Heffington moved to adjourn the meeting. Lori Barnes seconded the motion. All present voted aye. The meeting adjourned at 12:45 PM.
