In accordance with Governor Abbott's declaration of the COVID-19 public health threat, action to temporarily suspend certain provisions of the Texas Open Meetings Act, and Executive Order, a quorum of PBUWCD's Board of Directors will hold its Public Hearing meeting by telephonic conference call and, for redundancy, videoconference.
